Course: Laps are 0.9 mi, smooth pavement, one short hill (175m, 53x19 or 39x16), usually windy, no sharp turns, one slow 90 degree bend.

Series Championship: Leaders Jerseys will be handed out to each Overall Leader each week. One will go to the following categories: Cat 1/2/3, Cat 3/4, M40+, Women, Juniors, Cat 4. These will be returned each week, and the overall winner will keep one at the end of the Series.

Scoring System: 1st = 7 pts, 2nd = 5 pts, 4 pts, 3pts, 2pts, and 1 pt for 6th place. The last week will award 7 places per race with the winner getting 10 pts, then the next 6 places being the norm, i.e. 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. These are not USAC upgrade points - they do not count towards your upgrade.

Weather Cancellations: In event of ice or snowstorms check for a status on the website – the opening page will show status. Refresh the page to make sure you have the latest page available. Facebook Group "Bethel Spring Series" will be updated too.

Facilities/Misc: Portapotties onsite, please use them. Finishline camera. Computerized registration. Per town, no loud radios, no littering.

Driving directions: 84 to Exit 5, South on Rte 53, many turns etc, just follow 53 until the road becomes less industrial. There will be a light for the Francis J Clarke Industrial Park. Take the right there, go up the hill, and park on the side. If you pass under a narrow RR bridge followed by a 200-300m straight, you've gone too far. Approximate driving time from 84, about 20 min (considering lights etc).

From I95/Merritt: Rte 7 north, about 20 min later take a right on 107 in Georgetown, about 10 min later merge with 53 and immediately go straight on 53 (107 takes a right up a hill). About 10 min later pass under a RR bridge and take a left at the light for the Francis J Clarke Park.
